Step 1: Pick a designer that we've studied or will study from your book.

Please know your artist by Wednesday's class in Week 7 (though you can tell me sooner.)

Step 2: Research your designer. The textbook is a good jumping off point, but you are expected to use further sources. At least two of your sources must be physical materials, as opposed to simply relying on the internet (which is frequently an unreliable research tool). If your designer is alive, you could consider interviewing them.

Step 3: Begin writing, citing sources in the MLA format as you go. You should create a paper of between 5-10 pages in length. Font size is not to fall outside of the 10-12 point range, and you may 1.5, or double-space.

Bibliography required.

Your paper should answer the following questions, at least:

1. Who is/was your artist? When did they live and what was their background?
2. What movement(s) did/do they belong to?
3. What was/is their artistic perspective? What influenced or influences them?

Step 4! : Please prepare a creative way to present the paper **IN THE STYLE OF THE ARTIST**. The goal is to find some way, by website, newsletter, magazine or anything else you can dream up, to present the content of your paper visually. By now you should be fairly familiar with the artists's style, and capable of using it as inspiration.

Turn in: 1 project- physically or on CD/DVD.

If you go with the latter, you must label the disc and include a case for it. Please test your disc before turning it in. Physical printouts are fine as an alternative (but please, make sure they do your project justice.)

You must include a printed copy of your paper by itself in addition to whatever else you have created.



Projects will be returned after Friday of exam week in a bin on the first floor of Academic, by the front reception desk (in the office, through the glass door.)

Friends and family are invited to the project presentation. Please be prepared to show your project in some way, either electronically or physically. You **MUST** attend the final presentation for credit on this project, so plan ahead with plane tickets now.
